## Find your way – venue and hotels

### Warsaw

---

The main airport Warsaw Chopin Airport is located around 10 km from the city center. Taxi from the airport takes around 20/30 minutes and costs between 40-50 PLN. Train SKM S3 from station WARSZAWA LOTNISKO CHOPINA to station WARSZAWA CENTRUM (Central Railway Station) takes 20 minutes and costs 4,40 PLN (the train leaves once an hour).

### Venue
